iPhone users in the United States who would like to educate themselves in the U.S. health care industry can do so in a fun and attractive way from now on, through a [new game](#) from People Operating Technology, namely Death Panel. US Census shows that the total number of uninsured people in the country rose from 45.7 million in 2007 to 46.3 million in 2008. Moreover, 7.3 million of them were children under 18, yet the uninsured rate seems to be the lowest since 1987. What Death Panel for **the iPhone** tries to do is to educate people on these facts, and requires for the user to stand on a virtual platform and to answer correctly to questions about health care "from an anxious public." The game can be downloaded for free from the App Store.
